Gareth Parry, MB, ChB, FRACP, is Professor in the Department of Neurology at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, MN. He also serves as Medical Director of the University of Minnesota MS Center and the Clinical Neuroscience Research Unit. After receiving his medical degree from the University of Otago Medical School in New Zealand, he came to the United States to study neurology at the University of Pennsylvania. Before joining the Department of Neurology at the University of Minnesota, he held faculty appointments at the University of Pennsylvania, University of California at San Francisco, and Louisiana State University at New Orleans. He was also Chairman of the Department of Neurology at the University of Minnesota. His career-long research interest has focused on immune-mediated diseases of the nervous system, including multiple sclerosis (MS). He has been the principal investigator for numerous research studies of immunotherapies for MS. He has served on the Medical Advisory Board of the MS Society of Louisiana, and is currently Chair of the Clinical Advisory Committee of the National MS Society, Minnesota Chapter. His research has been published in many book chapters and peer-reviewed journals including *Neurology*, *Muscle Nerve*, and *Neurophysiology*. He is also an ad hoc grant and journal reviewer, and serves on editorial boards. He is an active member of professional organizations including his past role as President of the American Clinical Neurophysiology Society
