Applications are invited from the teaching faculty from **all the departments** (Pre,Para and Clinical) of Medical, Dental colleges and Super Specialty Institutions affiliated to RGUHS for attending residential training on Molecular Biology at Indian Institute of Science for the year 2020.

2. Eligibility Criteria:

- (1) Teaching Staff shall have minimum 10 years of service left in their service (They should not have crossed 50 years of age)
- (2) Post Graduate courses should be running in those departments where the applicant is working at present
- (3) Faculty working in all the Departments (Pre, Para and Clinical) of the Medical and dental Colleges are eligible to apply.

3. Application for training

- (1) The Application for applying for the residential training will be hosted on RGUHS Website (www.rguhs.ac.in/AdvancedResearch.html) as per the schedule mentioned above.
- (2) The interested candidates shall download the application and duly filled –in applications should be uploaded online in the portal. (www.rguhs.ac.in/AdvancedResearch.html).
- (3) The signed applications should be scanned and uploaded in PDF format in the above portal.
- (4) Softcopy of the application sent by email will not be considered. It has to be uploaded only in the portal mentioned above.

4. Selection Procedure

- (1) The Selection Committee will review the applications and finalize the list of candidates to be deputed for residential training.
- (2) Total number of candidates to be trained in the year 2020 is 100
- (3) There shall be three batch of training in a year
- (4) Number of participants in a batch is 33

5. About the Training:

- (1) Didactic lectures will be held between 9.00 a.m. to 11.00 a.m.
- (2) Hands-on Training will be provided between 11.00 a.m. to 06.00 p.m.
- (3) The hospitality arrangements such as accommodation and food will be provided by IISc.
- (4) Travelling Allowance will not be borne either by RGUHS or IISc.

All the above instructions should be strictly adhered to with regard to filling and submission of application both online and hardcopy, the failure of which will result in rejection of application
