### Surgical Oncology:

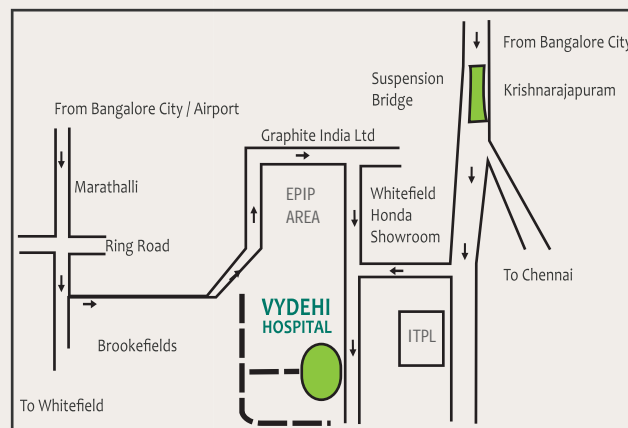

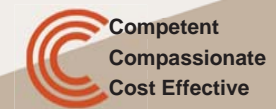
